Examination Section Annual Report 2013-14

Examinations and Results:

The year 2013-14 saw the stabilization of the various examination processes. The examination processes may be broadly classified as Initial, Pre, During and Post Examination processes. In the Initial Examination processes the following have been streamlined

- Board of Studies approved Panel of Examiners for each subject.
- Building up of a question paper bank for the various courses.
- Moderation of question papers to ensure the quality and standard of the question papers.
- A stock book with predefined reorder level for question paper setting is maintained.

The streamlined Pre-Examination processes begins with

- Drawing a question paper from the moderated question paper bank, typesetting and formatting it.
- Checking the question paper for correctness of English and grammar.
- Printing the required number of question paper copies and packeting them with appropriate Faculty, course, date wise and title wise label.
- Collecting the examination fee from eligible students.
- Issuing Hall Tickets
- Appointment of the Chief Superintendent for the conduct of examinations.(A norm is usually followed that the Chief Superintendent appointed is other than the exam going students' institution.)
- Appointment of an Observer for the smooth and fair conduct of the examination.
- Handing over the question paper packets bundled date wise to the Chief Superintendent.

The Examination process involves the following activities

- Subject experts have a final look at the question paper to check for errors, if any. In case there are some minor corrections, they are announced in the examination hall for students to correct the same.
- Monitoring of the conduction of theory examination with the CCTV cameras in the examination hall.
- Introduction of a single answer booklet for writing the examination. No supplements are given.
- The Observer is also asked to submit a subject wise consolidated absentee list for each course for which exams are conducted along with the Observer report. This report is used before the results are processed.

The Post Examination processes' streamlining includes

- Receiving answer scripts and tallying the numbers with the candidates present for the examination.
- Coding and double valuation of the answer scripts.

- Processing and publishing the results.
- Online provision of retotalling and /or photocopy of the answer script.
- Issue of marks cards, provisional degree certificates and degree certificate

Automation of Examination

Nitte University planned for automation of examination process in 2013, keeping in view that, credit of university always stem from the smooth conducting of examinations and timely declaration of accurate results. Logisys, was identified as service provider, with their Takshila software to process examination related activities for UG, PG, Super specialty courses etc. This software is totally parameterized and as such, can be implemented for any program of the university with minimum changes.

This system provide large number of validations at the appropriate stages. These validations are unique and they not only prevent invalid data creeping into the system, but also inform and guide the user when trouble shooting becomes inevitable.

The list of examinations conducted during the year and the analysis thereof is annexed herewith. Apart from these exams the pre Ph.D. course work examinations were conducted twice, once in June and once in December. The Ph.D. entrance exam was conducted in June. In addition, the Ph.D. thesis are sent for adjudication to three examiners (one within India, one outside India and the guide)as and when the candidates submit their thesis.

3rd Annual Convocation
