## **Examination Section Annual Report 2018-19**

Examination section of the Nitte (Deemed to be University) has been striving and continues to aspire to build in more transparency, conduct of foolproof examinations and announcement of results within shortest possible time frame i.e within 2 days to ten days of completion of examinations depending upon the batch size.

Examinations are conducted in the central examination hall. Presently it has

- A capacity of 325 to 350 students taking theory examination at one time, in case if the number of student is beyond 350, adjacent lecture hall is utilized for the conduction of the exam.
- A unitary seating arrangements is provided i.e every student has a single table and chair

The examination hall is fitted with 23 CCTV cameras and mobile jammers with the central room control in the Controller of Examination office.

Exclusive dedicated space is provided for data entry and scanning of answer scripts under CCTV surveillance monitored through in the controller of examination office.

Nitte (Deemed to be University) has adopted on screen marking system (OMS) from the academic year 2018-19 onwards. OMS is a procedure of applying technology to process of marking/scoring theory answer scripts with a view of improving quality, flexibility, efficiency, transparency while making the scoring process easier for evaluator. In this regard, 50 all in one desktops, 2 high end scanners and digital paper cutter are procured for the section and along with all other necessary infrastructural requirements are set up to enable the OMS.

### **Examinations Conducted during the year 2018-19**

The list of examinations conducted during the last academic year and the analysis thereof is annexed herewith. Apart from these exams the Pre Ph.D. course work examinations were also conducted twice in a year, (June and December). The Ph.D. entrance exam was conducted in June and December. In addition to this, Ph.D. thesis submitted by the research scholars are sent for adjudication to three examiners (one within India, one outside India and the guide)

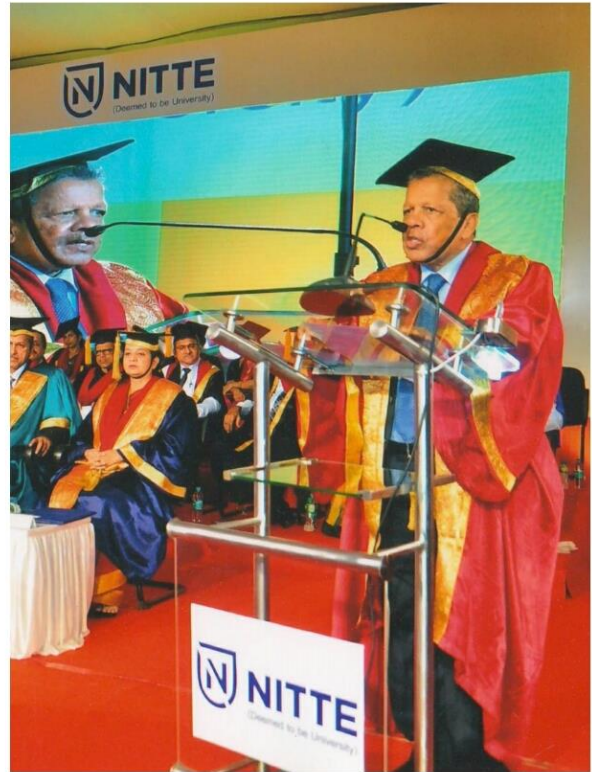
