Welcome by Chairperson-IQAC

Dr. Niranjan N. Chiplunkar, Principal & Chairman-IQAC opened the meeting by welcoming the external members Mr. Naveen Suvarna, Principal Director, Enterprise Minds, Karkala; Mr. Sudhakar Kotian, LIC Advisor, Halekatte, Kalya; Mr. Akshay Mashelkar, Founder, Experimind Lab Pvt. Ltd., AIC, NMAMIT, Nitte, and all the internal members.

Thereafter, the following points on the agenda were taken up for discussion:

- 1. Approval of the minutes of the previous IQAC meeting held on 2 March 2026**

Minutes of the previous IQAC meeting held on 2nd March 2026 were approved by the committee.

- 2. Approval of Action taken report based on the recommendations of IQAC meeting held on 2 March 2026**

The committee noted that no actionable recommendations necessitating follow-up were recorded during the previous IQAC meeting. Therefore, no Action Taken Report (ATR) was submitted for consideration.

- 3. Review of CO PO attainment of Odd semester 2025-26**

The IQAC Coordinator presented a summary of the Course Outcome (CO) and Program Outcome (PO) attainment analysis for the courses offered during the Odd Semester of the academic year

2025-26. It was observed that attainment levels were below the expected threshold for multiple COs in certain courses.

The Principal sought clarification on the proposed corrective measures and stressed the importance of implementing the identified action plans during the forthcoming academic cycle, particularly for first-year courses, to facilitate timely intervention and continuous improvement. For courses offered in higher semesters, the respective departments were advised to review the attainment analysis in departmental meetings, formulate suitable action plans, and implement the approved measures for subsequent batches of students.

4. Review of Institutional Performance half yearly report 2026

The performance of NMAMIT was reviewed against the targets set by the University. The Principal observed that there was significant scope for improvement in the development of SWAYAM courses and in securing both intra-mural and extra-mural research grants. In this context, the external member, Mr. Akshay Mashelkar, informed the committee that his organisation possesses a studio facility that could be utilised for recording online course content. He also shared information about an expert from a nearby institution who had successfully developed a SWAYAM course. The Principal suggested inviting the expert to interact with and guide interested faculty members of NMAMIT, with the objective of motivating and mentoring them in the development of SWAYAM courses. Further, the Principal recommended identifying faculty members willing to undertake the development of SWAYAM courses and providing them with the necessary support and guidance to facilitate the process.

5. Review of Strategic Development Plan (SDP) 2026-32 implementation

The Principal proposed adopting a broader and more inclusive approach towards the preparation of the Strategic Development Plan (SDP). He suggested that each department prepare a six-year SDP within the next two months. These departmental plans would subsequently be consolidated to formulate a draft institutional SDP, which would be presented for discussion and deliberation in the next IQAC meeting.

During the discussion on community-engagement internships undertaken by first-year students, the external IQAC member, Mr. Akshay Mashelkar, observed that while students often begin such initiatives with considerable enthusiasm, their motivation tends to diminish over time due to inadequate orientation and sustained guidance. In response, the Principal invited Mr. Mashelkar to address the incoming batch of students during the forthcoming induction programme to help instil the importance and value of community engagement activities. Mr. Mashelkar graciously accepted the invitation.

Mr. Suvarna readily consented to contribute to this initiative.
