#### **MINUTES:**

Dr. I. R. Mithanthaya, Secretary of Academic council heartily welcomed all VTU nominee Dr. Dilip Kumar K., Principal, K. S. Institute of Technology, Bengaluru, Mr. Ramachandra Acharya, Chief Technology Officer, Global Delight Technologies, Udupi, Dr. Niranjan N Chiplunkar, Principal NMAMIT, Dr. Srinivas Rao B. R, CoE, NMAMIT, Dr. A. N. Parameswaran, Director, Industry Institute Interaction, NMAMIT & all Heads of various department to the 21st Academic Council meeting. He briefly presented the agenda points for discussion and then invited Principal Dr. Niranjan N. Chiplunkar to deliver the opening remarks.

Dr. Niranjan N. Chiplunkar, Chairman of the Academic Council, in his opening remarks, highlighted that this is the final batch under the VTU Autonomous Scheme. He noted that the students have recently completed their examinations, received their results, and many have already secured placements. On this occasion, he announced that the Graduation Day will be held in two batches on 26th July and 2nd August 2025. He also recalled the institution's journey, stating that NMAMIT was established in 1986, introduced several new courses over the years, became an autonomous institution under VTU in 2007, and from 2021 onwards has been part of Nitte (Deemed to be University). He emphasized that this Academic Council meeting is significant as it is the final one under this scheme, convened to approve the list of eligible students for Graduation Day, as well as the list of gold and silver medal recipients with the highest CGPA. Dr. Chiplunkar expressed his gratitude to all Academic Council members for their consistent support and valuable suggestions over the years, which have greatly contributed to enhancing the teaching-learning process.

#### Vice Principal thanked Principal for his opening remarks.

A.C.21.1: As per agenda, Dr. I. R. Mithanthaya read all the resolutions of previous Academic council meeting held on 3 July 2024. He said, the approved scheme & syllabi of IV year B.E (under VTU) were followed during the academic year 2024-25, the approved open electives were offered in VII semester (1243 students opted Open elective in VII semester). The Institute also successfully conducted Graduation Day and issued the Graduation Certificate for all eligible students on 24 August 2024. All suggestions given by the Academic Council members were implemented during academic year 2024-25.

Academic Council members approved the minutes of 20th Academic Council Meeting.

**A.C.21.2:** Member Secretary sought approval for the list of students eligible for Graduation Certificates.

He reported that a total of 1,173 undergraduate students are eligible to receive the graduation certificate this year. He also presented the list of Gold and Silver Medal winners from the UG programs, recognizing those who achieved the highest CGPA in the semester-end examinations.

Academic council members approved List of eligible students for Graduation Certificate and List of Gold & Silver medal winners.

A.C.21.3: Dean (Academics) sought approval for examination-related matters during the meeting. Principal presented the consolidated result analysis of VII & VIII semester end examination across all branches and said a total of 1,239 students appeared for the VII semester end examination out of which 1110 students successfully cleared the exam without any backlog and resulting in an overall pass percentage of 92.25%. Out of graduating Cohort, 89.59% of students secured distinction and only 96 students failed in one, two or three subjects. Similarly, the VIII Semester End Examination was held in May 2025 and total 1239 students were appeared for the examination out of which 1219 students (98.63%) cleared all papers. A majority of students completed internships in reputed companies. Totally 1143 students successfully graduated during the year 2024-25. He expressed content with the placement outcomes, noting that over 700 students secured single job offers and more than 150 students received multiple offers. He highlighted that one student achieved an exceptional annual package of ₹52 lakh, underscoring the institution's academic excellence and strong industry readiness of its graduates.

He informed that an Industry Enclave was recently held in Mangalore with the participation of over 18 companies. The discussions centered on improving placement outcomes as well as fostering the holistic development of students.

He also noted that more than 70 students from the previous batch have secured placements in international companies

Dr. Dileep Kumar appreciated the faculty of NMAMIT for their outstanding efforts in motivating and guiding students toward academic and professional excellence.

Mr. Ramachandra Acharya appreciated the Institution's efforts in achieving excellence, particularly in placement activities. He further suggested enhancing the marketing strategy to showcase the Institution's initiatives and strong placement records to the outside world. The Academic Council members subsequently approved the examination-related matters

A.C.21.4: Member Secretary invited all external and internal Academic Council members for the forthcoming Institution's "Graduation Day" celebration of on 26 July 2025 and 2 August 2025. Principal said this year, the Institution is planning to conduct the Graduation Day Celebration in two sessions to accommodate all graduating students and their families. The First Session was scheduled on Saturday, 26th July 2025 (CS, CC, CV, ME, RAI & BT) and the Second Session was scheduled on Saturday, 2nd August 2025 (IS, EC, EE & AIML).

Principal thanked all HoD and all the external members for their valuable suggestions given during the entire academic council meeting.

Dr. I. R. Mithanthaya once again expressed his heartfelt thanks to all the member for their valuable suggestion given during the academic council meeting.
