A hydrothermal unit for renewable diesel production research has been installed at the Biofuel Centre, funded by a project grant from Nitte University. In addition, an on-road engine (Tata Sumo model) has been repaired and is now ready for installation to operate on 100% biodiesel. Biodiesel has also been successfully produced using waste oil from a jackfruit processing company.
