On the occasion of our College Day, with great pride I want to share with you the success of our students and the experience in achieving them. As I look back, this academic year 2017-18 has brought many accomplishments and also made us to see the gaps in some areas where there is a definite scope for improvement.

Students:

We have 586 students on roll now, of which 273 are boys and 313 are girls. In B.Sc - 32, B.Com - 420 and BBA – 134 students. We have admitted in this academic year 13 students to B. Sc course, 50 students to BBA and 137 students to B.Com.

Results of 2016-17:

Overall results were good. In final B.Sc out of 14 students who appeared for the examination, 12 have passed making it 85.7%. Out of them 10 have passed with distinction and 2 have secured first class. In final BBM out of 41 students, 28 have passed making it 68.3 %. Out them, 8 have passed with distinction and 3 passed with first class. In final B.Com out of 119 students, 107 have passed making it 89.9%. Out of them 54 have distinction and 35 students passed with first class.

Ms. Srinidhi C Shetty secured highest marks in Financial Accounting paper in V and VI Semester B.Com Degree examination held during April/May 2017 by the Mangalore University in the University level. She was awarded with GOLD MEDAL during the Mangalore University convocation held on 26th Feb, 2018.

The overall percentages were 80% and 50% in I and II year B.Sc, 67.50 % and 64.4% in I and II BBA and 87.89% and 94.61 % in I and II year B.Com respectively.

We appreciate the hard work put in by all the students and teachers concerned to make such high results possible.

Faculty:

We have 25 teaching staff and 14 non-teaching staff. Dr. Jaishree Shetty and Mr. Shrikanth Udupa from the Dept. of Commerce & Mgt and Mrs. Akshatha Dept. of Mathematics have left the college for better prospects. The College places on record their dedicated service to the institution.
