# **Annual Report 2019-2020**

#### Introduction

On the occasion of our College Day, with great pride I want to share with you the success of our students and the experience in achieving them. As I look back, the academic year 2019-2020 has brought us many accomplishments and also made us to see the lacuna in some areas where there is a definite scope for improvement.

#### **Students**

In our college, we have 589 students. Among them 250 students are male, and 339 students are female (which is of boys and girls ratio 4:5) students. There are 52 students have enrolled for B. Sc, 381 students have enrolled for B.Com, and 156 students have enrolled for BBA. In this academic year, the college has admitted 23 students to B.Sc, 60 students to BBA, 99 students to B.Com (G), and 14 students to B.Com (V). Around 45 boys and 31 girls are accommodated in the hostel.

#### Results of April/May 2019 Examinations

The overall result of the academic year 2018-19 was excellent. The percentages of the pass were 84.61% and 75% in I and II year B.Sc respectively, 65.90% and 77.50 % in I and II BBA respectively, and 88.32% and 92.24 % in I and II year B.Com respectively. In the final B.Sc., the college has achieved a 100% result. A total of 4 students appeared for the examination. Among them, 3 students passed with I Class. In the final BBM, among 37

students who have appeared for the semester examination, 33 passed (89.2%). Among them, 15 (41%) students passed with distinction. In the final B.Com, among 151students who have appeared for the examination, 138 students have passed (91.4%) the exam. Among them, 114 (75%) students passed with distinction.

Among the 192 students who have appeared for the Final Year degree examinations during April/May 2019, 89 students have enrolled for their Post-Graduation currently and 30 students were placed in the campus recruitment have been working at various places.

During the 38<sup>th</sup> Convocation of the Mangalore University held on 27 February 2020, **Ms. Sujana** received Gold Medal from the vice-chancellor of Mangalore University for securing the highest marks (300/300) in the subject Financial Accounting in V and VI Semester B.Com Degree examination. The Management, Principal, Staff members, and Student of Dr. NSAM First Grade College congratulate her on this occasion.

We also appreciate the hard work put forth by all the students and concerned teachers to make such high results possible.
